NOTES:

1. This report reflects current enrollments only; it does not include students registered for late start classes that have not yet started.
2. District headcount is unduplicated. Headcount across locations may be duplicated; that is, a student who is taking courses at both the Monterey campus and Education Center at Marina would be counted in both locations.
3. The 17.7% decrease in Latino enrollment in the district is largely a result of the District ending its enrollment agreement with FIELD (Farmworker Institute for Education & Leadership Development) last year. Most of the students enrolled through this program were Latino.
4. The dramatic increase in enrollment at the Education Center at Marina is related to an increase in the number of sections offered at that location. This semester there are 60 sections, compared to 12 sections in spring 2008.
5. FTES cannot be computed or inferred from headcount or units enrolled.
